Funded solely by employee contributions, our **Be The Good Fund** supports programs seeking to enrich the lives of women, children, and veterans. Our mission is simple: To do all the good you can, by all the means you can, in all the ways you can.

General Information:

All nonprofits are invited to apply; however, funding requests must support one of the focus areas of the Fund: **Women, Children, Veterans or Education**. Applications are accepted all year long, but funding is awarded in June and December. Final funding is voted on by employees of Canvas.

Requests for funding must be made via the application below. Funds will not be granted without an application. Grants may be funded in full, in part, or declined. Nonprofits are only eligible to receive funding once a year, but no more than two years in a row.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be an official 501c3 in good standing with the IRS
- Administrative costs must not exceed 15% of total expenditures
- Must operate in a community in which a Canvas employee lives
- Services provided by grant funding must be made available to all members of the community regardless of sex, race, religion, political affiliation, ability to pay, or background

Ineligible:

- Athletic teams, booster clubs or support organizations
- Bequests or memorials
- Campaigns (including Capital & United Way)
- Religious or political organizations
- Fraternities, sororities, or alumni groups
- Individuals or fraternal organizations
- Ministries, theological or bible schools
- Sponsorship Requests
- Public or Private Schools
- Pledges, tithes, or tuition
- Professional associations
- School choirs, bands or drill teams
- Scouting organizations
- Subscriptions, dues, insurance premiums or student fees
- Memberships
